- Parent returning from or going to a place of conflict (Armed Forces)
- Death of parent/ sibling
- In extreme cases where a child has a diagnosis of ASD where the paperwork is evidenced and they have an EHCP.

Please work with us to ensure your child understands the importance of attendance and comes to school every day to maximise their learning time.
