Year 5/6 Billionaire Boy at Bradford Alhambra – Thursday 2nd April 2020

As a school we love to read and we encourage and promote reading at every opportunity! Therefore, as part of our '50 things to do before you leave Halfpenny Lane' Year 5/6 children will be experiencing a trip to the very famous Alhambra theatre in Bradford to watch the stage production of Billionaire Boy.

Please ensure that your child is at the Year 6 doors by 8:10am for registration. The coach will be setting off at 8:30am promptly and parents will be able to wave the children off. We will be returning to school around dinner time, after the performance. Your child needs to wear school uniform and please ensure they have their school coat with them.

The cost of the trip is £15 per child. This is a non-refundable contribution, however, if insufficient funds are received, the trip may have to be cancelled. If the trip is cancelled by school, the contributions are refundable. Trips are carefully costed, but should there be any surpluses they will be dealt with as per the Charging & Remissions policy, which is available on the school website.

We highly recommend that you use ParentPay as electronic payments are safer and reduce the risk of money going missing. If you do not have a ParentPay account, you may visit the office, and a member of staff will help you set up your account. Please note, teachers and the office are no longer permitted to receive payments by cheque or cash. Permission slips and payments need to be returned and paid to school no later than **Monday 23rd March 2020**.

All children will need to take bottle of water and a snack with them as well as a 'sweet treat' for the interval of the production, if they so wish. As we will be returning to school toward the end of lunch, please provide the children with a packed lunch for this day. If your child receives Free School Meals and requires a packed lunch, please inform us on the reply slip so we can prepare this for them.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, then please provide them with the appropriate medication before arriving at school and any medication that needs to be administered on the trip, please state this in the space provided and hand directly to class teachers on the morning of the trip. Any children with asthma **must bring their inhaler** and give it to their class teacher.
