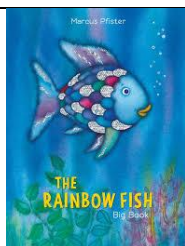


Nursery Home Learning Project – week beginning 6/7/2020

Literacy

- Can you draw and label your own rainbow creature? Can you copy or write over the letter shapes to write a word?
- Can you retell the story to a grown up?
- Can you write the sounds in your name using lots of different colours?
- Can you draw a rainbow and say the colours?

Mathematics

- Listen to the story again and count how many sea creatures there are altogether in the story. Which is the largest/ smallest sea creature?
- Can you find some sea creature toys at home? Can you count how many there are?
- Could you paint some fish and sea creatures onto rocks and stones? Could you count them and write the numbers?

Other Activities

- Draw/paint/ collage your own rainbow creature. Can you say the colours you have used?
- Create an octopus with 8 paperchain legs:



- How many triangle shark teeth can you cut out? Can you create a shark picture with them?
