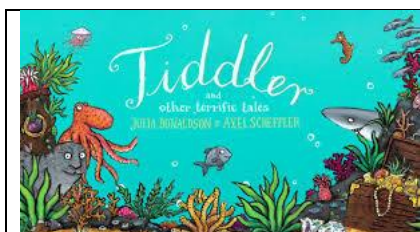


Nursery Home Learning Project – week beginning 13/7/2020

Literacy

- Make up your own story about why Tiddler was late to school one day.
- Write a register for your toys/ people in your house, and make sure that everyone is at school!
- Can you retell the story to a grown up?
- How do you think Tiddler felt when he was lost?

Mathematics

- Can you draw lots of fish on the paper? Can you count them? Can you write the number?

- Draw a shape fish, using a circle for the body, and triangles for the fins and tail.
