Maths

This term in maths, we are continuing our development of shape, multiplication & division and finally we will cover money.

Ask your child to show you a new piece of information they have learnt in Maths – can you solve their problem? We'd love to see – send us a picture on dojo!

Please encourage your child to access timetable Rockstars and sumdog – they are great programmes to reinforce learning.

History

This term year 2 will be learning about expeditions to the South Pole.

Can you research any famous explorers from the past?

Geography

This term we will be naming the 5 oceans and looking at different conditions around the world.

Why are some parts of the planet hotter than others?

DY

This term we will design, make and evaluate a poster with a sliding mechanism.

Can you find any real life examples of sliding mechanisms?

PSHE

This term we look at families and people who care for us.

Can your child bring a picture of their family into school?

RE

This term we will be exploring a Christian and Muslim place of worship and then make comparisons.

How do places of worship support local communities?

Science

This term in Science children will be learning about:

Where can we see different types of animals locally?

Art

Using a range of fabrics, we will create an ocean picture, using sewing techniques.
