This is what your child will be learning in school. As always, we welcome your support and encourage you to talk and explore some of these with your child at home.

Maths

This term in maths, we are continuing our development of multiplication, division and length and perimeter.

Ask your child to show you a new piece of information they have learnt in Maths - can you solve their problem? We'd love to see send us a picture on dojo!

Please encourage your child to access timetable Rockstar and sumdog – they are great programmes to reinforce leaning. Their focus within lessons is the 3- and 4-times tables.

History

This term year 3 will be exploring the history of the Vikings. This will include looking at the lives of the Vikings and how they travelled. Are there any facts you could pass on to your child that you know?

Geography

This term we will be looking at different biomes across the world and why each area may be different.

Over the coming weeks, encourage your child to look at what biome they live in and how they can identify it!

RE

This term we will be exploring different areas of Hindusim, Christianty and Islam.

Would love to hear if you are a part of a religion and how this reflects in your everyday life!

Science This term in Science children will be learning about: Forces including magnets. Does your child know different forces (pushes and pulls) that they use every day?

We will continue to learn numbers from 0 to 10 and also develop their verbal communication in conversation. Can you say 0-10 in Spanish?

Music

This term in music we will be exploring music and looking at the skill of improvisation. Are you able to improvise a beat/song on the spot?

Reading - all students are expected to read 4 times a week and ensure it is recorded in planners. Spellings, SPAG & Maths – all students are expected to complete this in their homework books.
