Maths

Please practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, as well as counting forwards and backwards in ones from any given number within 100.

History

This term, Year 1 will be learning about The Great Fire of London.

Please discuss fire safety with your children.

Geography

This term, we are learning to name cities in the UK.

How have cities changed over time?

DT

This term, pupils will be exploring structures and shelters.

How have buildings changed over time?

PSHE

This term we will learn about keeping ourselves safe.

How does technology help us when dealing with an emergency?

RE

This term we will be learning about Judaism.

How do different cultures celebrate special occasions?

Science

This term in Science children will be learning about:

Art
