Maths

This term in maths, we are focusing on Investigations.

Ask your child to show you a new piece of information they have learnt in Maths – can you solve their problem? We'd love to see – send us a picture on dojo!

Please encourage your child to access timetable Rockstar and sumdog – they are great programmes to reinforce learning.

History

This term year 6 will be exploring changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

Geography

This term we will be looking at plotting routes on a map and describing it using instructions, grid references and compass bearings.

PSHE

This term we look at puberty and the changes it has on the male & female body.

RE
