This is what your child will be learning in school. As always, we welcome your support and encourage you to talk and explore some of these with your child at home.

Maths

This term in maths, we are learning number and place value alongside recapping prior skills taught in reception. Ask your child to show you a new piece of information they have learnt in Maths - can you solve their problem? We'd love to see -

See if your child can spot different numbers in the environment e.g. what number is that house? What number is written on that sign?

History

This term, Year 1 will be learning about Magna Carta, specifically King John I. Why was the Magna Carta important for **English people?**

Geography

This term, we will be developing our knowledge of the weather in the UK. How do the seasonal and daily weather patterns change throughout the year?

DT

This term, pupils will be expanding on their knowledge of moving mechanisms,

PSHE This term we will learn about respectful relationships. What part of a relationship shows respect?

RF

This term we will be exploring Christianity. Point out local places of worship to your child and discuss their features.

Science
