This is what your child will be learning in school. As always, we welcome your support and encourage you to talk and explore some of these with your child at home.

Maths

In maths, we will focus on recognising numerals and counting to 10. We will also learn to count objects and match them to their numeral.

Ask your child to write numbers 1-6 in order. If they're feeling confident, practise numbers 1-10.
