This is what your child will be learning in school. As always, we welcome your support and encourage you to talk and explore some of these with your child at home.

Maths

This term in maths, we are learning addition and subtraction and shape alongside recapping prior skills taught in term 1.

Ask your child to show you a new piece of information they have learnt in Maths —

information they have learnt in Maths – can you solve their problem? We'd love to see – send us a picture on dojo!

Please encourage your child to access TTRockstars and Sumdog – they are great programmes to reinforce learning.

History

This term, Year 2 will be understanding why the people affected by conflict should be remembered.

Why is it important to remember the people who have been affected by conflict?

Geography

This term, we will be understanding how a compass is used and identifying simple directions.

How can a compass be used to locate human and physical features on a map?

DT

This term, pupils will design, make and evaluate a range of different healthy sandwiches.

How does design make food appealing?

PSHE

This term we will explore ways to keep healthy and their importance.

How can I keep myself fit and healthy?

RE

This term we will be understanding what happened during religious celebrations.

How do we celebrate special and sacred times?

Science

This term in science, we will understand and explain the changes which occur in the world around us during Autumn and Winter and how these changes affect humans, animals and plants.

How might we know what season it is?

The Tiger who came to Tea

Art

This term, we will be exploring drawing and painting skills to create a still-life image.

How can I create a still life painting based upon the work of Paul Cezanne?

Computing

This term, we will create an animal design using paint.

How can I represent art using a computer?

PE

Full kit is required *Monday* for PE, where we will be learning about net and wall games and team games.
