

Maths

This term in maths, we are going to be continuing practising our addition and subtraction skills within 20, learning about place value up to 50 and investigating height and length.

Ask your child to show you a new piece of information they have learnt in Maths – can you solve their problem? We'd love to see – send us a picture on Dojo!

Please encourage your child to access Top Marks so that they can play some maths based interactive games with you at home.

History

This term, Year 1 will be comparing similarities and differences between technology in the past (1960's) and present.

Has technology changed our lives for the better?

Geography

This term, we will be understanding the difference between human and physical features on a map. We will even create our own maps!

What are the physical and human features of Pontefract compared to others?

DT

This term, pupils will be exploring methods of production and understanding material properties and usage.

How and why do engineers strengthen structures?

PSHE

This term, we will recognise the risks and harmful content of the Internet and understand how to stay safe online.

Can the internet hurt you?

RE

This term, we will be understanding religious practices, retelling the Easter story and its importance.

How and why do we celebrate special times?

Science

This term, in science, we will be identifying everyday materials, distinguishing between objects and the material which it is made from.
