This is what your child will be learning in school. As always, we welcome your support and encourage you to talk and explore some of these with your child at home.

Maths

This term in maths, we are learning about place value (within 20) and addition and subtraction.

There are number everywhere. Where might you see numbers when out and about in the world? Ask your child to show you a new piece of information they have learnt in Maths.

History

This term, Year 1 will be learning more about our own locality (Pontefract). We will be investigating Pontefract Castle and discussing the history of liquorice. How has liquorice been important for the people of Pontefract?

Geography

This term, we will be considering the human and physical features of our school ground and local area, and comparing this to the features of a seaside town. What are the physical and human features of Pontefract?

DT

This term, pupils will design, make and evaluate a lever that relates to our class story – "The Gruffalo" Why does animation make a product more exciting?

PSHE

This term we will explore mental wellbeing and the importance of speaking up when needed. We will also talk about how to control our emotions.

How can I look after my mental health?

RE

This term we will be finding out about the religion of Islam and what Muslims believe. What do Muslims believe?

Science

This term in science, we will understand and explain the basic needs of animals and humans. We will discuss why certain animals are adapted to their habitats, as well as what their
