Year 3 – Term 4



English

This term in English we are reading:

The Chocolate Tree by Linda Lowery and Richard Keep.

This term, we will start by writing our own Mayan folk tales. Then, we will be writing an information text linked to our trip to the mosque. Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation is taught daily and will focus on using tenses and sentence types.

DT

Maths

This term, in maths, we are focusing on length and perimeter, mass capacity as well as fractions. Pupils will learn about improper fractions and finding their equivalents. They will also learn to order, add and subtract fractions.

History

How has the Maya civilisation influenced modern-day society? The pupils with learn about the importance of Gods and the role of farming on the Maya civilisation - making comparisons between modern-day farming.

Geography

How is Fairtrade helping climate change?
Pupils will learn about Fairtrade and will be able to identify Fairtrade products. They will learn about food miles and how this effects climate change.
