PSHE

This term we look at reproduction and puberty – both important topics to explore in a safe environment.

English

This term in English we are reading:

The Boy at the Back of the Class

Our writing is linked to this book- we will be learning how to write a short narrative and a information text.

Please ask your child what our audience and purpose of these texts are.

Spelling, grammar and punctuation is taught every day and is always linked in with our writing skills. This term our focus is: range of conjunctions, range of cohesive devices, parenthesis, relative clause and modal verbs.

Maths

This term, in maths, we are continuing to develop our maths skills, focusing on: decimals and percentages, Area and perimeter and statistics.

History

How did the early Islamic civilisation become such a major world power?

This term, Year 5 will be exploring Early Islamic Civilisation... Are there any facts you could pass on to your child that you know?

Art

Pupils will create a perspective window piece showing the inside of an apartment and an external scene with a creature.

DΤ

Pupils will use structural understanding and knowledge of materials to create a refugee shelter.

RF

This term we will be exploring Christianity, exploring how religion can influence Christian behaviour.

Science
