Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing to learn a variety of number rhymes and learning to count sets of objects. We will be recognising numbers to 5 and beyond and simple shapes such as squares, circles, rectangles, triangles and hexagons. We will be making patterns with shapes and drawing sets of objects.

Expressive arts and design

We will enjoy taking part in lots of creative activities. The children will use paint, clay, collage, ink and printing to create artwork based around Spring and the world around us. We will also enjoy singing a variety of rhymes and seasonal songs.

English
