Year 2 – Half Term 5



Maths

This term in maths, we are learning fractions and time, alongside recapping prior skills taught in the previous terms.

History

Pupils will draw appropriate comparisons between the lives, activism and achievements of Rosa Parks and Emily Davison.

How did Rosa Parks and Emily Davison help to overcome inequality?

Geography

Pupils will study geographical similarities and differences through the exploration of human and physical geography of two contrasting places.

How do key features differ between the UK and Kenya?

DT

Pupils will design, make and evaluate a hand puppet, which can be used to entertain children in EYFS.

Why do children enjoy watching puppet shows?

PSHE

Pupils will be able to identify ways they can stay safe and healthy and explain how to report concerns.
