Maths

This term in Maths, we will be finishing our Length and Perimeter topic, before moving onto Fractions.

Discuss with your child where they would use measurement and perimeter in their daily lives.

Remember, to spend time on TTRs and Hit the Button.

History Pupils will be conducting a local history study of the town of Pontefract.

What do you know about the history of Pontefract castle? Why not visit Pontefract museum and explore the fascinating exhibits!

Geography

Pupils will learn all about continents and countries. They will compare different capital cities across Europe.

How is a city different to a town or village? Visit a city and discuss what you can see. Look on YouTube to find videos of cities around the world, how are they the same/ different? Spanish ¡Hola! This term, the children will be learning how to say the days of the week in Spanish.

What Spanish words can you remember?

RE Pupils will compare how belief systems shape peoples' lives and the actions they make. What do different people believe about God?

Science

Children will continue exploring forces and magnets. They will understand and explain the concept of magnetism and understand how magnets can attract, repel, or have no effect on different materials.
