Maths

This term in maths, we are continuing to develop our maths skills, focusing on: Decimals and percentages, perimeter and area and statistics.

Please encourage your child to access timetable Rockstar and sumdog – they are great programmes to reinforce learning.

History

This term year 5 will be exploring the history, politics and religious sacrifices surrounding the war.

Geography
