Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing to learn a variety of number rhymes and learning to count sets of objects. We will be recognising numbers to 5 and beyond, and simple shapes such as square, circle, rectangle, triangle and hexagon. We will also be learning to compare objects by weight, height and length.

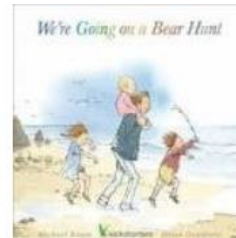
Understanding the World
