#### **Maths**

In Maths, we will continue to focus on numbers beyond 10. We will consolidate our learning of composition and look at how we can compose numbers from beyond 10. We will consolidate our learning around addition within 10 and introduce subtraction.

We will recall doubling facts and explore halving.
