This is what your child will be learning in school. As always, we welcome your support and encourage you to talk and explore some of these topics with your child at home.

Maths

This term in maths, we are learning about place value to 100, money and time. Ask your child different questions while out shopping related to money. Can they help pay for an item, recognising the coins and notes needed?

See if your child can spot different numbers in the environment e.g. what number is that house? What number is written on that sign?

Art

This term, pupils will create a photographic scene of an evacuation. How can I create a photograph scene of an evacuation, and a life drawing of a WW2 evacuee based upon historical evacuation photographs?

Geography

This term, pupils will be able to explain which seas surround the UK. Which sea have you visited, can you find it on a map?

DT

This term, pupils will design, make and evaluate a free-standing shelter. What factors affect the performance of a shelter?

PE

Full kit is required on a **Friday** for PE, where we will be completing invasion games and ball skills.

RE

This term, pupils will be able to reflect on and compare religious creation stories. What do religions believe about how the world was created?

Science

This term, pupils will understand and explain the changes which occur in the world around us during the seasons and how this affects humans, animals and plants. **How might we know what season it is?**

History

This term pupils will be able to explain how the fire spread and describe how this influenced modern day Britain. How did the Great Fire of London change the way that buildings look today?

PSHE

This term, Pupils will be able to understand how to stay safe in various environments and explain ways in which to respond in an emergency.
