

This is what your child will be learning in school. As always, we welcome your support and encourage you to talk and explore some of these topics with your child at home.

Maths

This term in maths, we are learning fractions and time alongside recapping prior skills taught in the previous terms, including lots of problem solving.

Ask your child to create their own word problem to match a simple number sentence. They could even try a two step problem!

Art

This term, Pupils will create a photographic scene of an evacuation.

How can I create a photograph scene of an evacuation, and a life drawing of a WW2 evacuee based upon historical evacuation photographs?

Geography

This term, pupils will be able to explain which seas surround the UK

Which seas surrounded the UK and where they are located?

DT

This term, pupils will design, make and evaluate a free standing shelter.

What factors affect the performance of a shelter?

PE

Full kit is required *on a Monday* for PE, where we will be completing invasion games and ball skills.

RE

This term, pupils will be able to reflect on and compare religious creation stories.

Science
