This is what your child will be learning in school. As always, we welcome your support and encourage you to talk and explore some of these topics with your child at home.

Maths

This term in Maths, we are focusing on time, shape, measurement and statistics.

Encourage your child to read the clock at home. What time do they get up? Have breakfast? Go to school? Go to bed?

How long does it take to walk to school? Can they answer questions involving time?

History

Pupils will learn about WWII. Pupils will learn about the foundations of the war, and the countries and key figures involved. They will understand and explain the key events of the war and the significance of the Battle of Britain. Who was impacted the most during WWII and how did their lives change?

Geography

Pupils will learn about Countries and Cities. Pupils will locate and identify UK cities and compare. Pupils will understand the importance of a coast, and threats to the coast from erosion.

Can you compare two UK cities, using physical and human features?

Spanish Children will learn how to express what they like to do in their spare time. What Spanish words can you remember?

RE

Pupils will explore different stories within the Bible. Why is the Bible so important to Christians today? Do you know any stories from the Bible? Can your child retell any to you?

Science

Pupils will explore how our bodies move and function. They will learn about the digestive system and will identify different types of teeth in humans. The pupils will also describe and investigate the roles of the skeleton. **How do our bodies move and function?**

Our Castle by the Sea

Art Pupils will create a Hockney-like painting.

Who is your favourite artist? Do you know the names of any painters? Computing Pupils learn how to present information, using PowerPoint. Can your child tell you what a slide, text box, font or hyperlink is?

PE

In PE, pupils will be developing their football, tennis, athletic and swimming skills!

Children should bring their PE kit on a Tuesday.

Year 4 – Term 6



English This term, we are reading *Our Castle by the Sea, by Lucy Strange*.

We will also explore poetry every Monday and a non-information text every Tuesday during Reading for Purpose.

The pupils will sing in unison to the song 'Bringing us together'.

Which songs do you enjoy listening to where the artists sing in unison?

Homework:

English & Maths – all students are expected to complete this in their homework books and hand in every Monday.
